This is a fast-paced food operation and requires an individual that can multitask and thrive in a fast-paced environment. This is a part-time, seasonal position with scheduling flexibility.

- Experience working in a fast-paced environment is a plus
- Ability to stand for long periods of time and lift 25lbs
- Detail oriented, team player
- High standard for cleanliness
- Excellent communication and organizational skills

- Following food safety guidelines and food service sanitation procedures
- Food preparation and packaging
- Operate Point of Sale system to fulfill orders
