This position will join the experienced, award-winning, fun, and fast-paced team responsible for organizing this popular summer tradition that offers a diverse range of performances from June to October each year. Events include weekly concerts, food and music festivals, national touring acts, film and a full production musical presentation, and more.

### **Position Detail:**

The Camp ENCORE! Camp Music Director will work under the supervision of the Camp Director. The Music Director needs to be available for camp sessions Monday through Friday; June 16<sup>th</sup> through August 9<sup>th</sup>, from 8:15am to 5:00pm; additionally for one day of training leading up to the start of the first camp session.

- Skills

The successful candidates will possess the ability to work well under pressure, demonstrate strong leadership skills, and have a genuine passion for working with children and teamwork in a camp setting. Additionally, the music director will have a mastery of teaching music and playing the piano. Ideally looking for candidates that are personable, dynamic, and motivational. These persons must be extremely organized with excellent communication, a formidable work ethic and strong problem-solving skills. Responsible and ethical are absolutely critical characteristics for this candidate because of the nature of the work with children.

Candidates with background in theater, musical productions, performing arts, have some experience/familiarity with camp and/or theatre are strongly encouraged to apply.

- Duties

Some duties include, but are not limited to:

- Perform daily music lessons with campers, teaching music fundamentals as necessary, as well as teaching the music for our show
- Teaching and working outdoors with a keyboard
- Teach music for five different shows within the eight weeks of camp
- Communicates effectively with staff and parents/guardians on daily basis
- Helps to create/manage daily theatre lessons, instruction of show materials and camp games
- Serve as a positive role model who supplement the positive environment that is *Camp ENCORE!*
- Passion for Theater, Singing, Music, Dance
- Must be over the age of 18 to apply
